#### **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS TO TENDERERS**

#### SUBMISSION OF TENDER

Tenders must be submitted in original and as per details given in other clauses/Formats enclosed and Appendices given hereunder. Reservations, if any, regarding the tender conditions should be clearly brought out in a separate letter accompanying the tender.

Addenda to this tender document, if issued, must be signed and submitted along with the tender document.

#### **DOCUMENTS**

The tenders, as submitted, will consist of the following:

- i. Complete set of tender documents as issued duly filled in and signed by the tenderer as prescribed in different clauses of the Tender Document and Formats provided.
- ii. Power of Attorney by the authorized representative who has signed the tender.
- iii. Information regarding tenderer in the Performa/Formats enclosed.

#### All Pages to be Initialed

All signatures in tender documents shall be dated as well. All pages of tender documents shall be initialed at the lower right-hand corner or signed wherever required in the tender papers by the tenderer or by a person holding power of attorney authorizing him to sign on behalf of the tenderer before submission of tender.

#### Rates to be in Figures and Words

The tenderer should quote in English both in figures as well as in words as specified in the Tender as percentage over declared rates. The tendered amount for the work shall be entered in the tender and duly signed and stamped with seal by the tenderer.

#### Signing of Tender

The tender shall contain the name, residence and place of business of person or persons making the tender and shall be signed by the tenderer with his usual signature. Partnership firms shall furnish the full names of all partners in the tender. It should be signed in the partnership name by all the partners or by duly authorized representative followed by the name and designation of the person signing. Tender by Corporation shall be signed by an authorized representative, and in Power of Attorney in that behalf shall accompany the tender. A copy of constitution of the firm with names of all partners shall be furnished.

Where a tenderer signs a tender in a language other than English, the total amount tendered should, in addition, be written in the same language. The signature should be attested by at least one witness.

#### Witness

Witnesses and sureties shall be persons of status and property and their names, occupation and address shall be stated below their signatures.

#### Details of Experience

The tenderer should enclose documentary proof to show that he has previous experience in having successfully completed in the recent past, works of this nature, together with the names of Owners, location of sites and values of contract. Refer Formats enclosed

#### **Transfer of Tender Documents**

Transfer of tender documents purchased by one intending tenderer to another is not permitted.

#### **VALIDITY**

Tenders submitted by tenderers shall remain valid for acceptance for a period of Three months from the date of opening of the tender. The tenderers shall not be entitled during the said period of three months, without the consent in writing of Registrar - BVB, to revoke or cancel his tender or to vary the tender given or any terms thereof.

#### ADDENDA

Addenda to the tender document may be issued prior to the date of opening of the tenders to clarify documents or to reflect modifications in the design or contract terms.

Each addendum issued by the Architect / Registrar BVB will be published on the website of BVB-DELHI KENDRA and is required to be downloaded by the bidder. Each bidder will retain one copy of each addendum for submission along with his tender and return one signed copy to the Architect / Registrar BVB as acknowledgement of receipt of the addendum. All addenda issued by the Architect / Registrar BVB shall become part of Tender Documents.

#### RIGHT TO ACCEPT OR REJECT TENDER

The right of acceptance of tender will rest with Registrar BVB. However, Registrar - BVB does not bind itself to accept the lowest tender, and reserves to itself the authority to reject any or all the tenders received without assigning any reason whatsoever. The whole work may be split up between two or more contractors or accepted in part and not entirely, if considered expedient.

Tenders in which any of the particulars and prescribed information are missing or are incomplete in any respect and/or the prescribed conditions are not fulfilled are liable to be rejected.

Canvassing in connection with tenders is strictly prohibited and tenders submitted by the Tenderers who resort to canvassing will be liable to rejection. Tender containing uncalled for remarks or any additional conditions are liable to be rejected.

BVB-DELHI KENDRA reserves the right to enhance or reduce the scope of work for which no compensation will be admissible and paid.

#### **SECURITY DEPOSIT**

Any defect identified during the said period will be removed by the Contractor at his own cost to the satisfaction of the PM – BVB. The Security retained by BVB-DELHI KENDRA will be released with any interest on the retained amount on completion of the Defect Liability Period and the contractor shall make a request in writing along with NOC obtained from the Project Manager

The earnest money deposited with the tender shall be adjusted towards security deposit, provided it is furnished by demand draft only.

The intending bidder must read the following terms and conditions carefully. He should only submit his bid if he considers himself eligible and he is in possession of all the documents required.

- 1. This information and instructions for bidders are provided in this document.
- 2. The bid document consists of Specifications, Schedule of quantities of various types of items to be executed and the set of terms and conditions of the contract to be complied with and other necessary documents can be seen and downloaded from website <a href="https://www.bvbdelhi.org">www.bvbdelhi.org</a>
- 3. Contractor will submit Tender in the Hard Format in Two separate Envelops consisting of Technical Bid and Price Bid.
- 4. Contractor must ensure to quote rate of each item-
- 5. If a tenderer quotes nil rates against each item in item rate tender or does not quote any percentage above/below on the total amount of the tender or any section / sub head in percentage rate tender, the tender shall be treated as invalid and will not be considered as lowest tenderer.
- 6. The Eligibility Bid (Technical Bid) shall be opened first on due date and at the time as mentioned above.
- 7. The bidder should have Average Annual Financial Turnover of Rs.10 Lacs (i.e. 30% of estimated cost put to tender (ECPT) on construction works during the last three years ending 31<sup>st</sup> March-2025 as per the balance sheets duly audited by the Chartered Accountant. Year in which no turnover is shown will also be considered for working out the average. The annual turnover figures shall be brought to current value by enhancing the actual turnover figures at simple rate of 7% per annum (Copy of Certificate to be submitted)
- 8. The bidder should not have incurred any loss (profit after tax should be positive) in more than two years during available last five consecutive balance sheets, duly certified and audited by the Chartered Accountant. (The balance sheet in case of Pvt./ Public Ltd. company means its standalone financial statement and consolidated financial statement both)
- 9. The bidders should have a Banker's Certificate (format prescribed in Form B) from a commercial Bank for Rs.14.54 lacs (i.e. 40% of ECPT) certified by his Bankers or

"If work is awarded to me, I/we shall obtain GST registration certificate, as applicable, within one month from the date of receipt of award letter or before release of any payment by BVB, whichever is earlier, failing which I/we shall be responsible for any delay in payments which will be due towards me/us on account of the work executed and/or for any action taken by BVB in this regard".

#### **FORM 6 for Tendering**

The empanelment of contractors should be valid on the last date of submission of bids. In case the last date of submission of bid is extended, the empanelment of contractor should be valid on the original date of submission of tenders.

- 1. The work is estimated to cost Rs.36,34,990 /-. However, this estimate cost is merely for rough guidance.
- 2. Agreement shall be drawn with the successful bidders on prescribed Form No. 7 (or other standard form as mentioned). Bidders shall quote his rates as per various terms and conditions of the said form which will form part of the agreement.
- 3. The time allowed for carrying out the work will be 30 days from the date of start as defined in schedule 'F'.
- 4. All the site is available for work.
- 5. GST or any other tax on material /work as applicable shall be paid by the agency himself and nothing extra shall be paid on this account afterwards. The agency shall quote his rates considering all such taxes.
- 6. Further that, if such a violation comes to the notice of BVB, then I/we shall be debarred for bidding in BVB in future forever. Also, if such a violation comes to the notice of BVB before date of start of work, the Project Manager shall be free to forfeit the entire amount of Earnest Money Deposit/Performance Guarantee. - 9. Earnest Money in the form of Demand Draft shall be drawn in favour of "Bharatiya Vidya Bhawan" payable at New Delhi
- 10. The earnest money shall only be acceptable in the form of Demand Draft .

#### Scope and particular specifications of work

#### 1.1 Scope of work

It is proposed to avoid cutting of trees to the maximum extent and instead transplant of the affected trees, within the site or in the vicinity, in a phased manner. Total 32 trees (approximately) are to be transplanted. These numbers are indicative only and the actual number may liable to change during actual execution at site. The sizes and species of trees are subject to confirmation and NOC granted by Delhi Forest BVB for transplantation and Survey shall be done by the bidder to ascertain the number of trees before starting the work.

The work of transplantation of is envisaged to ensure that these valuable trees are translocated in a scientific manner thereby ensuring that they survive the transplantation procedure. It is proposed that the agency shall transplant the planting material at site and reasonable field adjustment may be made to ensure proper implementation of the said work.

#### **Particular Specifications of work**

#### 1.2 General Guidelines

- 1.2.1 Transplantation of trees from one location to another site is a major operation. The work shall be executed & supervised by a well experienced person in this type of work. Roots investigation, Diagnosis of health & treatment of infected area must be done before initiation. Care must be taken while production of root ball by digging mechanically or manually all around the tree, carefully cutting the roots, then wrapping the root ball in netting. The difficulty is to handle the root ball without causing deformation to it.
- 1.2.2 The work shall be executed & supervised by a well experienced person in this type of work. Analysis of the soil at the proposed transplant site where the tree has to be translocated shall be carried out. Analysis should include tests of pH, Organic Matter, Major and Trace Elements and Exchangeable cations.
- 1.2.3 The transplantation process including excavation, transporting and planting should be completed within the same day. Shorter transplantation time can provide better conditions for the survival of seedlings.

#### 1.3 Preparation of Trees:

- 1.3.1 Formative Pruning: Selectively remove specific branches to enhance form and improve structure, and to directionally shape the tree. With smaller diameter branches it may be necessary to reduce the branch to a dormant bud. Formative Pruning shall aimto reduce the development of structural weaknesses and to accommodate site constraints and reduce encroachment on utilities as the tree grows.
- 1.3.2 Root Excavation, Preparation, Requirements and Responsibilities: Root pruning and soaking shall be carried out a minimum desirable period before transplanting. Preparation of the root system, that is, a circular partial cutting of the roots all around the tree is to be done before transplanting.
- 1.3.3 Prior to digging, the soil around the root system shall be thoroughly moistened to help keep the root ball together. The root ball shall be excavated around the outside of the root trench. All exposed roots shall be pruned flush with the face of the root ball. Sharp Blades shall be used

to cut the roots. Roots shall be cut in a way that will not jar and loosen the soil in the root ball.

- 1.3.4 The diameter of the excavated root system or soil ball should be five times the diameter of the base of the tree trunk, but not less than 40 cm. The depth of the excavation should be 2 to 3 times of the soil ball's diameter, but not shallower than 25 cm. The depth of the root ball shall depend on each individual tree species. Digging below the root ball shall occur when the number of roots reduce considerably within the root ball trench. Tension shall be applied by the crane while undercutting the root ball.
- 1.3.5 After being excavated, the tree trunk should be wrapped with protective materials (e.g. sackcloth, canvas). Natural fiber materials that have not been chemically treated shall be used to support the root ball. Synthetic materials shall not be used. The root ball shall be encased in biodegradable material such as jute twin, burlap etc. and then wired casing shall be installed over it to provide strength

#### 1.4 Excavation and Trenching:

- 1.4.1 All trenches 1.5 meters or more in depth shall at all times be supplied with at least one ladder for each 20 meters in length or fraction thereof. Ladder shall be extended from bottom of trench to at least 1 meter above surface of the ground. Sides of a trench, which is 1.5 meters, or more in depth shall be stepped back to give suitable slope, or securely held by timber bracing, so as to avoid the danger of sides collapsing. Excavated material shall not be placed within 1.5 meters of edge of trench or half of depth of trenches whichever is more. Cutting shall be done from top to bottom. Under no circumstances shall undermining or undercutting be done.
- 1.4.2 These safety provisions shall be bought to the notice of all concerned, by display on a notice board at a prominent place at the work spot.
- 1.4.3 Persons responsible for ensuring compliance with the safety code shall be named therein by the Contractor.
  - (i) To ensure effective enforcement of the rules and regulations relating to safety precautions, arrangements made by the Contractor shall be open to inspection by the BVB's Representative.
  - (ii) The Contractor is responsible to protect and maintain the areas of intermediate completed work from damages of the surface due to movement of operational vehicles / manpower or construction equipment, if any.
  - (iii) All chemicals, pesticides, fungicides to be handled with care and register to be maintained for how empty containers/ cans/ bottles are disposed.
  - (iv) Provision for drinking water, hand washing and toilet arrangement's to be provided to workers by agency.
- 1.4.4 The Tree must be supported during excavation to prevent damage by falling to one side.

#### 1.5 Preparation of receptor site

- 1.5.1 Trees will not tolerate highly compacted soil, which should be broken up over as large an area of the site as possible. Planting pits should be provided with drainage to allow effective percolation of water.
- 1.5.2 Any unsuitable material brought to the surface during excavation shall be removed from site. The planting hole shall be excavated by spade.

- 1.5.3 The root zone and base of trees should be free from shrubs or other planting to facilitate the proper establishment of trees.
- 1.5.4 During pit preparation, the existing topsoil ploughed from digging should be stripped and put aside for reuse as much as possible and to avoid a distinct interface between the planting pit and the surrounding soil.
- 1.5.5 The width and the final depth of a planting hole are determined by the depth and firmness of the root ball and other characteristics of the site. The soil directly beneath the root ball should be undistributed or prepared to prevent settling.
- 1.5.6 In general, the depth of the planting hole shall not exceed the depth of the root ball and the sides of the planting hole should be scarified to facilitate root penetration. In general, the planting hole width should follow international practice at a minimum of 1.5 times the diameter of the root ball to suit the location. If the depth of the hole exceeds the root ball height, compacted soil shall be added to the hole to prevent settling after transplanting. The bottom of the hole shall be de-compacted to a depth of 150 mm and lightly compacted

#### 1.6 Transportation

- 1.6.1 During transporting the tree to the new destination, cushions should be placed between the tree and the body of the vehicle, to avoid damaging the branches. The tree shall be fastened with ropes for safety's sake, regardless of how far it is being transported.
- 1.6.2 Loading, unloading, and handling shall be done gently and dragging shall be avoided while transporting. It shall be ensured that there are no damage to the soil ball or any scratching and splitting of the root system. The tree should be kept intact without injuries to its root system, trunk and crown.
- 1.6.3 The trees being transported shall be kept properly moistened, sheltered and protected from wind, over-watering, strong sunlight, rain, cold weather and theft all the time. The transplanting must be done as soon as root ball has been prepared. In case of delay, the prepared trees shall be stored in shady area and shall be covered with damp mulch.
- 1.6.4 Lifting of trees shall be carried out or supervised by a qualified and/or suitably experienced person and crane operator using a crane and supports.
- 1.6.5 The transport vehicle shall be adequate to transport the tree without damage/ congestion of crown.
- 1.6.6 The route shall be selected by the bidder to ensure sufficient vertical and horizontal clearances for the tree transportation and no extra payment shall be made on this behalf by BVB.
- 1.6.7 The transportation shall not cause public hindrance/ damage to any property in any manner. Charges/ penalty levied on the agency shall not be paid by BVB.
- 1.6.8 Crown of the tree shall be carefully wrapped/ tied to each other to minimize the risk of drying, branch damage due to excessive movements, and wind damage.

#### 1.7 Planting

- 1.7.1 Excavated soil may be used as backfill if it is free of weeds, deleterious materials and particles larger than 25 mm. When backfilling, sedimentary layers in soil shall be observed so topsoil remains above the subsoil.
- 1.7.2 Orientation The tree shall be orientated at the new site in the best suited direction and as per the requirement of the site.
- 1.7.3 The twine, burlap, and metal cage should be removed from at least the top third of a B&B root ball to avoid poor root growth and root girdling.
- 1.7.4 Backfill The backfilled soil should comprise 40% yellow soil, 20% pond silt, 10% organic fertilizers, 10% peat soil, 20% pumice and 0.1% moisturizer as required. There should not be any rocks or impurities larger than 1 cm in diameter in the soil. Any soil deficiencies shall be rectified prior to placing backfill.
- 1.7.5 Fertilizer and Soil Additives Requirements of fertilizer and/or other soil additives as per experienced person. The backfill shall be soil injected with a sucrose solution at 20 grams per liter of water and approximately 100 liters of solution applied per tree. Soil injections of Sucrose Solutions improve the defense system of stressed trees and increase the volume of new roots. Rooting hormone shall be mixed with the backfill material before the tree is positioned.
- 1.7.6 Tree Support: Supporting structures shall be immediately installed after planting, to prevent tree leaning. Structures of less than 20 cm in diameter should be made up of materials of at least 5 cm in diameter, while structures of over 20 cm in diameter should be made up of materials of at least 10 cm in diameter, and they should be firmly pressed at least 4 inches into the soil. The parts where the trunk is in contact with the structures shall be protected with thick soft materials (such as plastic or fabrics), to avoid injuries to the bark. The trees shall be fastened with ropes. For supporting pre or post transplantation of the trees, Scaffoldings or cranes shall be used.
- 1.7.7 Watering: Immediately following transplantation, each tree shall be soaked to remove air pockets from the soil. It shall be ensured that trees maintain health and are free of water stress at all times. Monitor moisture levels to determine the exact watering requirements to ensure tree survival. Water shall be applied to the entire root area and not just the immediate trunk base.
- 1.7.8 Maintenance: The tree shall be maintained for a period of five years by professional horticulturists. Regular inspection & instructions as given in this document should be followed for maintenance. The soil shall be kept constantly moist after transplanting. The excess water shall be drained off in time. During the maintenance period, avoid watering at noon when the weather is hot.

#### 1.8 Aftercare

- 1.8.1 Aftercare is vital to transplanting success. In addition to watering, aftercare may also include misting, weeding, mulching, support hardware, and follow-up visits.
- 1.8.2 The quality and quantity of backfill shall be such that it promotes rapid initial root development and does not restrict root spread beyond the planting hole.
- 1.8.3 Mulch shall be used to conserve soil moisture, to buffer soil temperature extremes to control weeds and other competing vegetation, and to replenish organic matters and nutrients in the soil. The size of the mulched area depends on the size of the tree. Mulch layer around 5 cm thick usually covers the area where roots will grow during the first two years after planting. However, mulch used shall be free from pests and diseases. The root zone and base of trees should be free from shrubs or other planting to facilitate the proper establishment of trees. Mulch should not be placed too close to the tree trunk or root collar
- 1.8.4 As the trees are to be transplanted within the site, the transplanted trees shall be protected with robust fencing covering the Root Protection Area.
- 1.8.5 Staking or initial guying used to retain a tree in an upright position until sufficient roots are developed, should be removed, replaced or adjusted as necessary to ensure their effectiveness and to prevent constriction or abrasion damage to the tree. In general, the supports can be removed after the tree establishment. Supports that stay too long without proper adjustment will do more harm than good to the trees.
- 1.8.6 The agency shall carry out social audit and get certified "Survival Assessment report" at the end of each maintenance sub-period (quarterly) to ascertain survival rate.
- 1.8.7 The agency shall adhere to all the technical specifications for carrying out tree transplantation in Delhi as issued from time to time by the BVB of Forests and Wildlife, GNCTD

#### 1.0 Special Condition

- 1.1. Time of completion for the work is 150 Days as per the approved program in phase and instructions of Engineer in Charge.
- 1.2. No material tools plants equipment electricity and water shall be provided by BVB and nothing extra shall be paid for this
- 1.3. The agency shall be responsible for safety and security of their material and staff the agency shall be liable for any damage to other's property material during the work.
- 1.4. The agency shall submit the methodology of tree transplantation before starting work.
- 1.5. The girth and height of the tree shall be measured and recoded before start of any activity Photographs of each tree before start of process of translocation shall be submitted by the bidder. The tree shall be geo tagged before and after tree transplantation.
- 1.6. All permissions needed for tree transplantation shall be taken from competent authority by the agency.
- 1.7. The entire process of transplantation shall be video graphed and submitted fortnightly

- to BVB. Penalty of Rs. 5000 per default shall be imposed if the agency fails to do so.
- 1.8. The Engineer in Charge reserves the right to request compensation regarding death or weakening of tree caused by negligence in following the guidelines every tree which doesn't survive after Transplanting shall be replaced with any native tree of almost similar parameters. Nothing extra shall be paid for this.
- 1.9. Invasive exotic tree species shall not be transplanted.
- 1.10. The agency shall coordinate with other agencies working on the site.
- 1.11. Agency shall mandatorily use Tree spade machine for transplanting trees up to 1000 mm girth. For trees with girth more than 1000mm, Tree spade machine shall be used as per the species and requirement at site.
- 1.12. Maintenance period of 5 (Five) Years shall commence after the complete job of transplantation of all trees as stipulated in the tender document is completed. Taking care of all transplanted trees till the maintenance period starts shall also be the responsibility of the agency.
- 1.13. At least 04 Nos. Mali should be provided during whole maintenance period of 1200 nos. trees.
- 1.14. The area around the transplanted tree shall be kept neat and tidy and all necessary steps shall be taken avoid mosquito and other such hazards thorough out the period of contract.
- 1.15. During execution of work any damage caused to Govt. property/articles by the labors, the same shall be got rectified by the agency and nothing extra shall be paid on this account.
- 1.16. The rates quoted by the contractor's should be including all royalty, GST, other taxes, carriages all lead and lifts and stacking etc. complete up to the site of work nothing extra shall be payable to him on this account.
- 1.17. No payment will be made to the contractor for damage caused by rains or other natural calamities during the execution of work and no such claim on this account will be entertained.
- 1.18. The location of storing and stacking of material shall be decided by the Engineer-in-charge.
- 1.19. All malba /rubbish / waste /garbage etc. generated during the day-to-day maintenance from work shall be disposed of on daily basis by the contractor to the specified common disposal point as directed by the engineer-in-charge.
- 1.20. The site shall be cleared from all type of rubbish, surplus T & P etc. complete in all respect at the time of completion of work.
- 1.21. The BVB shall not be responsible for any injury partial or permanent or death of any worker at site due to accident during functioning of the equipment or by negligence of the staff.
- 1.22. The good earth should be free from bricks, bats, stones, and gravels and fit for gardening.
- 1.23. The manure should be well rottened cattle manure free from foreign materials etc.

- 1.24. The contractor shall be responsible for damage of existing garden feature etc.
- 1.25. The contractor shall deposit the pruned tree branches to NDMC cremation center and shall mandatorily submit the receipt of the same to Engineer in charge.
- 1.26. The cut /felled trees shall be stacked at site as per the direction of Project Manager and the responsibility of safety of these stacked trees shall be in the scope of the contractor till the same is auctioned by the engineer in charge.
- 1.27. Wherever operations undertaken are likely to interface with public traffic, specific traffic management plans shall be drawn up and implemented by the contractor in consultation with the prior approval of local police authorities, and /or the concerned metropolitan/civil authorities as the case may be.
- 1.28. Such traffic management plans shall include provision for traffic diversion and selection of alternative route. If necessary, the contractor shall carryout road widening before commencement of works to accommodate the extra load. The contractor shall be responsible for getting the traffic management plan approved from traffic police before taking up activities on road.
- 1.29. The guiding principles to be adopted for safety in construction zone are to Warn the road user clearly and sufficiently in advance, provide safe and clearly marked lanes for guiding road users and marked buffer and work zones. The contractor shall provide adequate measures that control driver behavior through construction zones.
- 1.30. The primary traffic control devices used in work zones shall include signs, delineators, Barricades, cones, pylons, pavement markings and flashing lights, deployment of sufficient number of Marshalls on diversion roads.
- 1.31. Materials hanging over/ protruded from the chassis / body of any vehicle especially during material handling shall be indicated by red indicator (red light/flag) to indicate the caution to the road users.
- 1.32. Street sweeping and sprinkling of water at access road shall be carried out where ever soil/material is spilled by the agency and as per the directions Engineer in charge. Wheel washing at entry/exit shall be done.

#### 2. Safety Guidelines

- 2.1. The Contractor shall ensure a safe environment on the landscape area at all times. All safety provisions shall be properly maintained. All safety precautions and requirements shall be strictly complied with at all times.
- 2.2. Appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) shall be supplied and maintained for all workers. Minimum PPE shall include a hi-visibility jacket safety shoes, and gloves. Supervisors shall undertake a pre-inspection of roadside landscaping works to assess risks, if any.
- 2.3. Vehicles shall be parked off the roadway so as not to obstruct driver's view of the presence of workers. Vehicles shall not, under any circumstances, be driven against the normal flow of traffic.

- 2.4. Any vehicles used for landscaping should be registered, roadworthy and well maintained.
- 2.5. Carting material from one site to another to be under taken in such a manner as to cause minimum amount of pollution.
- 2.6. Supervisors should meet the workers and instruct them about the safety aspects of the day's activities prior to commencement of work.
- 2.7. Particular attention and planning are to be given to ensuring that landscaping works does not impede vehicle flow. Consideration needs to be given to the provision of traffic control/security staff where the work or the location requires the obstruction of the normal roadway.
- 2.8. 10% of the workforce/supervisors are to be trained in first aid: Establish and train supervisors in procedures for the rapid acquisition of emergency works in the event of an accident.
- 2.9. No landscaping or building materials are to be stockpiled or unloaded onto the road surface except while being moved into the work area, and even then, only when barricaded and signposted with reflective warning signs.
